Troupe A, B, C, D:

The "Triple Threat Performer" program is designed to provide an opportunity for the serious performer to delve into all critical areas of performing: acting, singing, tap, jazz, and private voice. (Audition required)

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS DANCE:

Beginner Ballet:

Basic fundamentals of the art form will be covered in order to set a solid foundation. Syllabus follows introductory Russian Method training concepts.

<u>Advanced Beginner Ballet + Pointe:</u>

Continued study of basic technique with the addition of exercises to prepare the student for Pointe work in near future. All students who are "En Pointe" will be allowed with instructor permission only. Syllabus follows formal work of Russian Method training.

Tap Skills:

We will rehearse tap steps and work on techniques involving intricate rhythms and combinations. Tap dancing is a great way to develop musicality, timing and balance.

Advanced Jazz:

Jazz dance includes strength, flexibility and conditioning technique and progressions including turns, kicks and leaps. Learn many fun and trendy dance steps that are used for all forms of dance. Dancers will learn choreography to popular and age appropriate music of today along with vintage styles of jazz from the last decades.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

GENERAL STUDY:

ACTING IS FUN:

This theatrically fun class will cultivate creativity, clever exploring & confidence!

INTRO TO PERFORMING:

Begin your performance education with improvisation, game playing, creative drama and vocal performance. Students will develop singing, acting and musical theatre skills through the analysis, rehearsal and performance of scenes and songs from select pieces.

PREP PERFORMERS:

In this class, we develop the fundamentals of acting, musical theatre, song, dance and stage personality. Recommended as the beginning class for our triple threat "want to be"'s!

STAGE MANAGEMENT:

This class offers an opportunity to learn the backstage skills necessary to organize and manage a production. Students will participate as a stagehand in the production by running sound, lights and/or stage-managing the production of your choice. This is a hands-on educational experience! Choose from the musicals RAISE YOUR VOICE, ELF or WIZARD OF OZ.. Class schedule will follow the production calendar.

TAC: TEEN ACTORS Class:

A drama class offered for our interested teen actors focusing on learning to delve into the art of acting. Students will explore acting in the form of live theatre in which the plot, character and dialogue of a game, scene or story are made up in the moment.

Vocal/Acting:

Continue your performance education with improvisation, game playing, creative drama and vocal performance. Students will develop singing, acting and musical theatre skills through the analysis, rehearsal and performance of scenes and songs from select pieces.

Ms. Rose has been teaching piano for 25 years and has degrees/certifications in music, education, and special needs. She teaches both traditional and Suzuki piano methods. incorporating technique, listening, and theory into each as appropriate. Weekly private lessons are geared to individual needs and interests; periodic group lessons bring perspective, socialization and further understanding of musical concepts with performance opportunities during the year. Ms. Rose works carefully to build strong foundations, enriching experiences and overall confidence. All ages and stages, 4 through adult, are welcome, and can start at any time during the year. - *Troupe students must register for at least one musical.
- *You may register for backstage stage management for both musicals, Grade 7-12.
